HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

IMMIGRATION BILL 1925.

*(Amendment to be proposed by the Prime Minister, the Right Honorable  
S. M. Bruce.)*

Page 3, clause 7, line 41, omit "make an order for his deportation",  
insert the following:—

"by notice in writing, summon the person to appear before a Board, at the time specified in the summons and in the manner prescribed, to show cause why he should not be deported from the Commonwealth.

"(2.) Sub-sections (2.) (3.) and (4.) of section eight A of this Act shall apply in relation to the Board mentioned in the last preceding sub-section."
