NOTICE OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT.

IMMIGRATION BILL 1925.

Mr. W. Maloney :—

Page 3, clause 7, at the end of the clause add the following :—

“8AC. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act or any other Act, it shall be mandatory that when any profiteer, whether individual or a company, has been proved to have made as much as or more than 100 per cent. profit on any food, drink, clothing or rent, he or they shall be deported. In any case in which any money lender or financial institution has been proved to have charged as much as or more than 25 per cent. during any current year, he or they shall be deported.”.
