IMMIGRATION BILL 1925.

*(Amendments to be proposed by the Prime Minister, the Right Honorable
S. M. Bruce.)*

Page 3, clause 7, line 32, after "time," insert "whether before or
after the commencement of this section, within three years
before the notice in writing referred to in this section,".

Page 3, clause 7, at the end of the clause add the following:—

"8AC. A person summoned to appear before a Board in pursuance
of either of the last two preceding sections shall be deemed not to
have been born in Australia unless he proves that he was born in
Australia."
