A BILL

FOR

AN ACT

To amend the *Northern Territory (Administration) Act 1910.*

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

- 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Northern Territory (Administration) Act 1925.* Short title and citation.
- (2.) The *Northern Territory (Administration) Act 1910** is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Northern Territory (Administration) Act 1910–1925.*
2. Section three of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the definition of “the Minister”. Definition of Minister.
3. Section eleven of the Principal Act is repealed. Disposal of Crown Lands.
