THE PARLIAMENT OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

Read 1° 11th February, 1926.

(Brought from the Senate.)

A BILL

FOR

AN ACT

To amend the *New Guinea Act 1920*.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

- 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *New Guinea Act 1926*. Short title and citation.
- 5 (2.) The *New Guinea Act 1920** is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *New Guinea Act 1920-1926*.
2. Section nine of the Principal Act is amended by inserting at Acting Administrator.
- 10 the end thereof the following sub-section:—
- “(3.) The exercise and performance of the powers and functions of the Administrator, during his absence from the Territory, by any person appointed under sub-section (1.) of this section, or by the senior officer of the Territory, acting under sub-section (2.) of this section, shall not affect the exercise or performance by the Administrator himself of any power or function.”
3. Section fourteen of the Principal Act is amended— Ordinances.
- (a) by inserting in sub-section (1.), after the word “in”, the words “, and in relation to,”; and
- 20 (b) by omitting from paragraph (c) of sub-section (2.) the word “fourteen” (wherever occurring) and inserting in its stead the word “thirty”.
