## A BILL

FOR

## AN ACT

To amend sections three and six of the *Sales Tax Assessment Act (No. 3) 1930.*

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :—

- 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Sales Tax Assessment Act* Short title and citation.  
**5** *(No. 3A) 1930.*
- (2.) The *Sales Tax Assessment Act (No. 3) 1930\** is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Sales Tax Assessment Acts (No. 3) 1930.*
- 10** 2. This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the date of Commencement. the commencement of the Principal Act.
3. Section three of the Principal Act is amended— Sales tax.
- (a) by inserting, after the word "Australia", the words  
 " , either before or after the commencement of this Act," ;  
 and
- 15** (b) by inserting, after the word " sold ", the words " on or after the first day of August One thousand nine hundred and thirty " .
4. Section six of the Principal Act is amended— Exemptions.
- 20** (a) by inserting at the end of paragraph (b) the word " or " ;  
 (b) by omitting from paragraph (c) the word " or " ; and  
 (c) by omitting paragraph (d).
