A BILL

FOR

AN ACT

To amend section three of the *Sales Tax Assessment Act (No. 6) 1930.*

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :—

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Sales Tax Assessment Act* Short title and citation.
5 (No. 6A) 1930.

(2.) The *Sales Tax Assessment Act (No. 6) 1930** is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Sales Tax Assessment Acts (No. 6) 1930.*

10 2. This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the date of Commencement.
the commencement of the Principal Act.

3. Section three of the Principal Act is amended— Sales tax.

(a) by inserting, after the word "Australia", the words " , either before or after the commencement of this Act," ; and
15 (b) by inserting, after the word "sold", the words " on or after the first day of August One thousand nine hundred and thirty".
