A BILL

FOR

AN ACT

To amend the *Wine Export Bounty Act 1930*.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

Preamble.

5 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Wine Export Bounty Act 1931*.

Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Wine Export Bounty Act 1930** is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

10 (3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Wine Export Bounty Act 1930-1931*.

2. Section four of the Principal Act is amended—

(a) by inserting in sub-section (3.), after the word "every", the word "proof"; and

Establishment of Trust Account and payment of bounty therefrom.

15 (b) by adding at the end of sub-section (3.) the words "together with a sum equal to five-elevenths of the amount paid by way of duty of excise under any Tariff or Tariff proposal paid on or after the fourth day of December One thousand nine hundred and thirty on concentrated grape must for use in the manufacture of wine".
