SCHEDULE OF THE AMENDMENT MADE BY THE SENATE.

Page 49, leave out clause 49, insert the following clause :—

“ 49.—(1.) The provisions of Parts VI., VII., VIII. and IX. of this Act to the extent to which they vary, or authorize the variation of, any periodical payment shall have effect in respect of any periodical payment made on or after the twenty-sixth day of October, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-three. Commencement
of variation in
periodical
payments.

(2.) For the purposes of this section ‘ periodical payment ’ means any payment by way of pension, salary, wage, fee or allowance which is ordinarily made at regular weekly, fortnightly, semi-monthly or monthly intervals, but does not include—

(a) any payment which is made on or after the twenty-sixth day of October, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-three and which relates wholly to a period the last date of which was prior to the twenty-fifth day of October, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-three ; or

(b) any payment affected by section thirty-five, thirty-six or thirty-seven of this Act.

(3.) Sections thirty-five, thirty-six and thirty-seven of this Act shall commence on the first day of November, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-three.”
