HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

FINANCIAL RELIEF BILL (1933).

(Amendments to be proposed by Mr. James.)

Page 38, clause 22, line 25, after "unemployment," insert "or the value of any food and lodging provided by a son or daughter for a parent, or by a parent for a son or daughter".

Page 38, clause 22, at the end of sub-clause (1.) add the following:—

" ; and (b) by adding at the end thereof the following sub-section:—

' (2.) For the purposes of this Act, husband and wife shall be deemed to be living apart if—

(a) they are doing so pursuant to a decree, judgment, order, or deed of separation ;
or

(b) they satisfy the Commissioner that they are not doing so for the purpose of avoiding the application to them or to either of them of any provision of this Act,

but not otherwise.' "

Page 38, clause 22, line 32, omit "This section" insert "The amendment effected by paragraph (a) of the last preceding sub-section".

Page 39, clause 24, line 12, omit "and".

Page 39, clause 24, at end of sub-clause (1.) add the following:—

" ; and (f) by omitting from sub-section (2.) the words 'pursuant to any decree, judgment, order or deed of separation.' "

New Clauses.

24A. Section twenty-five of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from paragraph (d) of sub-section (1.) the words "pursuant to any decree, judgment, order or deed of separation".

Assessment of value of accumulated property.

24B. Section twenty-six of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from paragraph (b) the words "pursuant to any decree, judgment, order, or deed of separation".

Rules for computing income.

27A. Section fifty-two of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from sub-section (2.) the words "pursuant to any decree, judgment, order or deed of separation".
