A BILL
FOR
AN ACT

To provide for Financial Assistance to States
in the Provision of Benefit and Assistance
to Growers of Mandarins.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble.
and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of
Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in
the House of Representatives, as follows :—

5 **1.** This Act may be cited as the *Mandarin Growers Relief Act 1934.* Short title.

2. Subject to this Act, there shall be granted to each State Payments
specified hereunder out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, which to States.
is hereby appropriated accordingly, by way of financial assistance
to that State, the amount specified in this section opposite the name
10 of that State, namely :—

3. Any money granted to a State under this Act shall be so granted Application of
