A BILL

FOR

AN ACT

To amend section five of the *Northern Territory
Representation Act 1922-1925*.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate,
and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of
Australia, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Northern Territory*
5 *Representation Act 1936*. Short title and
citation.

(2.) The *Northern Territory Representation Act 1922-1925**, as
amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Northern Territory*
Representation Act 1922-1936.

2. Section five of the *Northern Territory Representation Act 1922-*
10 *1925* is amended— Disabilities of
member for
Northern
Territory.

(a) by inserting in sub-section (1.), before the words "The
member", the words "Subject to the next
succeeding sub-section,"; and

(b) by inserting after sub-section (1.) the following sub-
15 section:—

"(1A.) The member representing the Northern Territory
may vote on any motion for the disallowance of any
Ordinance of the Northern Territory and on any amend-
ment of any such motion."
