HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

WHEAT GROWERS RELIEF BILL (No. 2) 1934.

*(Amendment to be proposed by the Minister for Commerce, the
Right Honorable Earle Page.)*

Page 2, omit clause 7, insert the following clause :—

“ 7. Where—

(a) any person—

(i) is the legal personal representative of a person
(since deceased); or

(ii) is the trustee of the estate of a person,
who has, during the year One thousand nine hundred and
thirty-four, sown wheat for grain; or

(b) any person, being the legal personal representative of a
deceased person or a trustee has, during that year, sown
wheat for grain on account of the estate of the deceased
person or of the trust estate,

any amount payable under this Act in respect of the wheat so sown
shall, notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, be paid to the
legal personal representative or trustee on account of the estate of the
deceased person or of the trustee, as the case may be.”
