No. 1.—Clause 2, page 2, line 6, omit “ and hardship ”.

No. 2.—Clause 2, page 2, at the end of the clause add the following words and sub-section :—

“ and that they are in such adverse financial circumstances as seriously to affect their ability to continue farming operations.

“ (3.) Any amount applied under this section by a State in providing relief to a wheatgrower, shall be paid directly to that wheatgrower, and the right of any wheatgrower to receive any such relief shall not be prejudiced by the fact that he does not continue as a wheatfarmer after the year One thousand nine hundred and thirty-four.”.
