THE PARLIAMENT OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Read 1^o 21st May, 1936.*(Brought from the Senate.)*

A BILL

FOR

AN ACT

To amend sections two and nine of the *Wireless Telegraphy Act 1905-1919*.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :—

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Wireless Telegraphy Act* Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Wireless Telegraphy Act 1905-1919** is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Wireless Telegraphy Act 1905-1936*.

10 2. Section two of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the definition of "Australia" and inserting in its stead the following definitions :— Interpretation.

15 " 'Australia' includes the Territories under the authority of the Commonwealth and the territorial waters of the Commonwealth and of any such Territory ;
'Territories under the authority of the Commonwealth' includes any Territory governed by the Commonwealth under a mandate ;".

3. Section nine of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following sub-section :—

“(3.) For the purposes of the application of this section in the Territories under the authority of the Commonwealth, ‘ Court of Summary Jurisdiction ’ includes a court of any such Territory sitting as a court for the making of summary orders or the summary punishment of offences under the law of the Territory.” 5
