MR. THORBY (Acting Minister for Commerce) to move—

That a tax, at rates to be prescribed by regulations made under the Act passed to give effect to this Resolution, but not exceeding the rates specified in the following Schedule, be imposed on all wool—

- (a) grown in Australia, and
 (b) shorn on or after the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-six.
