## A BILL

FOR

## AN ACT

Relating to the Territory for the Seat of  
Government.

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

5 **1.**—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act* 1937. Short title  
and citation.

(2.) The *Seat of Government Acceptance Act* 1909\*, as amended by the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act* 1910†, by the *Judiciary Act* 1927‡, and by the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act* 1933§ (as amended by the *Statute Law Revision Act* 1934¶), is in this Act  
10 referred to as the Principal Act.

(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act* 1909–1937.

**2.** Section five of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following sub-section:— Acceptance  
of Territory.

15 “(3.) The Territory shall be known as the Australian Capital Territory.”
