THERAPEUTIC SUBSTANCES BILL 1938.

*(Amendments to be moved by the Acting Minister for Health, the
Honorable A. G. Cameron.)*

(1) After clause 1, page 1, insert the following new clause:—

“ 1A. This Act shall commence on the date of the commencement Commencement,
of the Principal Act.”

(2) After clause 4, page 2, add the following new clause:—

“ 5. Section eleven of the Principal Act is repealed and the following
section inserted in its stead:—

‘ 11.—(1.) Any officer thereto authorized in writing by the Minister Examination
of therapeutic
substances.
may—

- (a) take samples of all therapeutic substances which are imported
or are sought to be exported and any samples so taken
shall be dealt with as prescribed; and
- (b) require any therapeutic substances specified by him which
are imported or are sought to be exported to be delivered
for examination or analysis, or both, to a laboratory
appointed by the Minister for the purpose, and any
therapeutic substances so delivered may be examined or
analysed, or both, accordingly.

(2.) No therapeutic substances shall be entered for home con-
sumption or exported unless and until a person or an officer thereto
authorized by the Minister certifies that all the provisions of this
Act with respect to their importation or exportation, as the case
may be, have been complied with.’”
