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1 **A Bill for an Act to amend the *Air Services Act***
2 ***1995, and for related purposes***

3 The Parliament of Australia enacts:

4 **1 Short title**

5 This Act may be cited as the *Air Services (Aircraft Noise)*
6 *Amendment Act 2011*.

7 **2 Commencement**

8 (1) Each provision of this Act specified in column 1 of the table
9 commences, or is taken to have commenced, in accordance with
10 column 2 of the table. Any other statement in column 2 has effect
11 according to its terms.

8 Each Act that is specified in a Schedule to this Act is amended or
9 repealed as set out in the applicable items in the Schedule
10 concerned, and any other item in a Schedule to this Act has effect
11 according to its terms.

2 **Schedule 1—Aircraft noise**

4 *Air Services Act 1995*

5 **1 Paragraph 8(1)(d)**

6 After “environment”, insert “and residential areas”.

7 **2 Subsection 9(2)**

8 Omit “the environment is”, substitute “the environment and residential
9 areas are”.

10 **3 Section 10**

11 Repeal the section, substitute:

12 **10 AA must consult and cooperate**

13 (1) In the performance of its functions and the exercise of its powers,
14 AA must, where appropriate, consult with government,
15 commercial, industrial, consumer, aircraft noise, community and
16 other relevant bodies and organisations (including ICAO and
17 bodies representing the aviation industry).

18 (2) During consultations, AA must advise other parties of how they
19 can make a complaint about AA’s conduct, if they so wish. This
20 advice must include that AA is within the jurisdiction of the
21 Commonwealth Ombudsman.

22 (3) AA must widely publish the details of its consultations, both before
23 and after they occur.

24 **10A Consulting with communities**

25 *General*

26 (1) Where AA has decided to propose changes in the management of
27 flight paths or airspace which would have, or be likely to have, any
28 impact on the environment or individuals’ enjoyment of their place
29 of residence, AA must:

- 1 (a) arrange for consultations on the proposal under section 10;
2 and
3 (b) advise the Minister responsible for the *Environment*
4 *Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999* of the
5 consultations; and
6 (c) request the Minister to appoint a Community Aviation
7 Advocate to represent the affected parts of the community
8 during the consultations.

9 *Consultation in relation to Perth flightpaths*

- 10 (2) As soon as practicable after the *Air Services (Aircraft Noise)*
11 *Amendment Act 2011* receives the Royal Assent, AA must propose
12 a plan for the management of flight paths relating to Perth, which
13 may be either the current plan or a changed plan.
14 (3) The proposal is taken to be a proposal to which subsection (1) and
15 section 10 apply.

16 **4 After paragraph 13(a)**

17 Insert:

- 18 (ab) the need to minimise the impact of aircraft operations on the
19 environment and residential areas;

20 **5 Paragraph 22(1)(d)**

21 Repeal the paragraph, substitute:

- 22 (d) between 6 and 8 other members.

23 **6 After subsection 22(5)**

24 Insert:

- 25 (6) The Board must include an expert in environmental management
26 and a representative of an aircraft noise or related community
27 group.

28 **7 After section 74**

29 Insert:

1 **74A Complaints reporting**

- 2 (1) In its annual report, AA must provide detailed commentary on
3 complaints made in relation to its conduct.
- 4 (2) The commentary must cover the efficiency and effectiveness of
5 AA's handling of complaints.
- 6 (3) The commentary must cover the transfer of information and
7 complaints between AA and the Commonwealth Ombudsman.

9 ***1999***

10 **8 Paragraph 160(2)(b)**

11 After "environment", insert "or individuals' enjoyment of their place of
12 residence".

13 **9 After section 160**

14 Insert:

15 **160A Community Aviation Advocate**

- 16 (1) Where the Minister receives advice under section 10A of the *Air*
17 *Services Act 1995* that Airservices Australia is proposing changes
18 in the management of aircraft noise or airspace which would have,
19 or would be likely to have, a significant impact on the environment
20 or individuals' enjoyment of their place of residence, or forms this
21 opinion through other means, the Minister must appoint a
22 Community Aviation Advocate in relation to these changes.
- 23 (2) The role of the Community Aviation Advocate is to assist, inform
24 and advocate on behalf of the parts of the community likely to be
25 affected by the proposed changes in subsection (1).
- 26 (3) The Community Aviation Advocate must be independent of
27 aviation interests.
- 28 (4) The duties, duration and basis of appointment, and remuneration of
29 the Community Aviation Advocate must be commensurate with the
30 work required in fulfilling the Advocate's role.
