**A Bill for an Act to amend the *Maritime Transport and Offshore Facilities Security Act 2003*, and for related purposes**

The Parliament of Australia enacts:

**1 Short title**

This Act may be cited as the *Maritime Transport and Offshore Facilities Security Amendment (Inter-State Voyages) Act 2015*.

**2 Commencement**

- (1) Each provision of this Act specified in column 1 of the table commences, or is taken to have commenced, in accordance with column 2 of the table. Any other statement in column 2 has effect according to its terms.

1. Sections 1 to 3 and anything in this Act not elsewhere covered by this table	The day this Act receives the Royal Assent.	
2. Schedule 1	A single day to be fixed by Proclamation. However, if the provisions do not commence within the period of 6 months beginning on the day this Act receives the Royal Assent, they commence on the day after the end of that period.	

Note: This table relates only to the provisions of this Act as originally enacted. It will not be amended to deal with any later amendments of this Act.

- (2) Any information in column 3 of the table is not part of this Act. Information may be inserted in this column, or information in it may be edited, in any published version of this Act.

### 3 Schedules

Legislation that is specified in a Schedule to this Act is amended or repealed as set out in the applicable items in the Schedule concerned, and any other item in a Schedule to this Act has effect according to its terms.

## **Schedule 1—Amendments relating to inter-State voyages**

### ***Maritime Transport and Offshore Facilities Security Act 2003***

#### **1 Section 10 (definition of *inter-State voyage*)**

Repeal the definition.

#### **2 Paragraphs 16(1)(a), (b) and (c)**

Omit “or inter-State”.

#### **3 At the end of subsection 16(1)**

Add:
