## Archives Regulations<sup>2</sup> (Amendment)

I, THE ADMINISTRATOR of the Government of the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby make the following Regulations under the *Archives Act 1983*.

### Principal Regulations

1. In these Regulations, "Principal Regulations" means the Archives Regulations.

2. After regulation 7 of the Principal Regulations the following regulation is inserted:

### Relevant offices—paragraph 34 (8) (c) of the Act

"7A. (1) For the purposes of paragraph 34 (8) (c) of the Act, an office specified in Column 3 of an item in Schedule 1A is declared to be the relevant office in respect of the Commonwealth institution specified in Column 2 of that item in that Schedule.

"(2) A reference to an office in Column 3 of an item in Schedule 1A is a reference to that office in the Commonwealth institution specified in Column 2 of that item."

3. The Principal Regulations are amended by inserting before Schedule 1 the following Schedule:
