Freedom of Information (Miscellaneous Provisions) Regulations² (Amendment)

Principal Regulations

1. In these Regulations, "Principal Regulations" means the Freedom of Information (Miscellaneous Provisions) Regulations.

Schedule 1

2. Schedule 1 to the Principal Regulations is amended—

- (a) by omitting—
"Australian Bicentennial Authority"
and substituting—
"ACTION Liaison Committee
Australian Bicentennial Authority";
- (b) by omitting—
"Australian Capital Territory Heritage Committee"
and substituting—
"Australian Capital Territory Co-ordinating Committee for the National Tree Programme
Australian Capital Territory Heritage Committee
Australian Capital Territory International Youth Year Co-ordinating Committee"; and

- (c) by inserting—
“Housing Branch Advisory Committee”
after—
“Commonwealth Accommodation and Catering Services Limited”.

Schedule 2

- 3. Schedule 2 to the Principal Regulations is amended—
 - (a) by omitting item 25;
 - (b) by omitting item 156 and substituting the following item:
“156 Overseas Telecommunications Commission (Australia) Managing Director”; and
 - (c) by inserting in its proper numerical position in that Schedule each of the items set out in Schedule 1 to these Regulations.

Schedule 3

- 4. Schedule 3 to the Principal Regulations is amended—
 - (a) by omitting item 1 and substituting the following items:
“1 ACTION Liaison Committee Minister of State for Territories
1A Australian Bicentennial Authority Prime Minister”; and
 - (b) by inserting in its proper numerical position in that Schedule each of the items set out in Schedule 2 to these Regulations.
