Superannuation (Eligible Employees) Regulations² (Amendment)

I, THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL of the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby make the following Regulations under the *Superannuation Act 1976*.

Commencement

1. These Regulations shall come into operation on 16 February 1987.

Persons not included in definition of "eligible employee"

2. Regulation 4 of the Superannuation (Eligible Employees) Regulations is amended by adding at the end the following paragraph:

"(x) persons who—

- (i) immediately before 16 February 1987 were employed under the *Public Service Act, 1978* of the State of Western Australia, as amended and in force at that time, and were not members of a superannuation scheme established under a law of that State;
- (ii) having been appointed to be officers of the Australian Public Service on 16 February 1987 pursuant to Division 9A of Part III of the *Public Service Act*, have continued to be, and are, such officers; and
- (iii) have not requested that they be treated as eligible employees."
