**Family Law Regulations<sup>2</sup> (Amendment)**

**1. Amendment**

1.1 The Family Law Regulations are amended as set out in these Regulations.

**2. New regulation 18A**

2.1 After regulation 18, insert:

**Prescribed maximum period—subsection 112AG (6) of the Act**

“18A. For the purposes of the definition of ‘maximum period’ in subsection 112AG (6) of the Act, 200 hours is prescribed in relation to each State and Territory.”.
