AMENDMENT OF THE PAPUA NEW GUINEA (APPLICATION OF LAWS) REGULATIONS†

1. (1) The Papua New Guinea (Application of Laws) Regulations are amended by re-numbering regulation 17 (second occurring), being a regulation inserted by Statutory Rules 1974, No. 221, as regulation 17A. Cessation of
