## REGULATIONS UNDER THE COAL EXCISE ACT 1949-1966.\*

I, THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby make the following Regulations under the *Coal Excise Act 1949-1966*.

### AMENDMENTS OF THE COAL EXCISE REGULATIONS†

1. Regulation 4 of the Coal Excise Regulations is amended by omitting the Licence-fee words "One pound" and inserting in their stead the words "Two dollars".

2. Regulations 8 and 8A of the Coal Excise Regulations are repealed and the following regulation is inserted in their stead:—

"8.—(1.) An entry under section 24 of the Act to authorize the removal of Entries. coal for home consumption shall be in accordance with, or substantially in accordance with, Form 32 in the Schedule to the Excise Regulations.

"(2.) An entry under section 24 of the Act to authorize the removal of coal for exportation shall be in accordance with, or substantially in accordance with, Form 34 in the Schedule to the Excise Regulations."

3. Forms 4 and 4A in the Schedule to the Coal Excise Regulations are Schedule. repealed.
