1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the *International Transfer of Prisoners (Transfer of Sentenced Persons Convention) Amendment Regulations 2007 (No. 1)*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the day after they are registered.

3 Amendment of *International Transfer of Prisoners (Transfer of Sentenced Persons Convention) Regulations 2002*

5 Application of the Act

- (1) For section 8 of the Act, the Act applies to each country specified in Schedule 2, subject to the Convention.
- (2) However, subregulation (1) does not apply to the United States of America for the transfer to Australia of a prisoner serving a sentence of imprisonment ordered by a military commission established under chapter 47A of title 10 of the United States Code.
