Citation

1. This Determination may be cited as Currency Determination No. 14 of 1993.

Commencement

2. This Determination commences on 22 November 1993.

Specifications and design of a \$10 coin

3. (1) This clause sets out the specifications and design of a coin of the denomination of \$10 the standard composition of which includes not less than 92.5% silver.

(2) The shape of the coin is circular.

(3) The edge of the coin is milled.

(4) The standard weight of the coin is 20.00 grams.

- (5) A variation of 0.500 grams from the standard weight is allowed.
- (6) The diameter of the coin is 34.10 millimetres.
- (7) The thickness of the coin is 2.90 millimetres.
- (8) The obverse of the coin bears:
- (a) an effigy of the Queen; and
 - (b) the inscriptions "ELIZABETH II", "AUSTRALIA" and "1993".
- (9) The reverse of the coin bears:
- (a) a representation of a Palm Cockatoo; and
 - (b) the inscriptions "TEN DOLLARS"; and
 - (c) a small motif of the United Nations Environment Program logo.
- (10) This clause does not affect any other determination of the specifications or design of a coin.
