**Citation**

1. This Determination may be cited as Currency Determination No. 3 of 1994.

**Commencement**

2. This Determination commences on 11 May 1994.

**Application**

3. This Determination does not affect any other determination of the specifications or design of a coin.

**Specifications and design of a \$1 coin**

4. (1) This clause sets out the specifications and design of a coin of the denomination of \$1 the standard composition of which includes not less than 99.9% silver.

- (2) The shape of the coin is circular.
  - (3) The edge of the coin is milled.
  - (4) The standard weight of the coin is 31.635 grams.
  - (5) A variation of 0.500 grams from the standard weight is allowed.
  - (6) The diameter of the coin is 40.60 millimetres.
  - (7) The thickness of the coin is 4.00 millimetres.
  - (8) The obverse of the coin bears:
    - (a) an effigy of the Queen; and
    - (b) the inscriptions "ELIZABETH II", "AUSTRALIA", and "1 DOLLAR";all encircled by raised beads inside the rim of the coin.
  - (9) The reverse of the coin bears:
    - (a) a representation of 2 kookaburras perched on a branch of a tree; and
    - (b) the inscriptions "THE AUSTRALIAN KOOKABURRA 1 OZ. 999 SILVER" and "1994"; and
    - (c) a small motif of the logo of the Australian team that will participate in the 1994 Commonwealth Games;all encircled by raised beads inside the rim of the coin.
