**DECLARATION OF DESIGNATED OUTWARDS SECONDARY SHIPPER
BODY PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION 10.03(2)
OF THE TRADE PRACTICES ACT 1974**

WHEREAS I, JOHN DUNCAN ANDERSON, Minister of State for Transport and Regional Services, am of the opinion that:

- the Federal Chamber of Automotive Industries represents the interests, in relation to outwards liner cargo shipping services, of shippers in Australia of passenger, light commercial and four-wheel drive motor vehicles and motor cycles, and related spare parts and components; and
- that it is desirable that the Federal Chamber of Automotive Industries be a designated outwards secondary shipper body for the purposes of Part X of the *Trade Practices Act 1974*.

NOW I, pursuant to subsection 10.03(2) of the Act hereby declare the Federal Chamber of Automotive Industries to be a designated outwards secondary shipper body for the purposes of Part X of the *Trade Practices Act 1974*.
