1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the *Financial Management and Accountability Amendment Regulations 2008 (No. 6)*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence as follows:

- (a) the day after they are registered — regulations 1 to 3 and Schedule 1;
- (b) on the commencement of the *Australian Organ and Tissue Donation and Transplantation Authority Act 2008* — regulation 4 and Schedule 2.
