**1 Name of Regulations**

These Regulations are the *Criminal Code Amendment Regulations 2009 (No. 13)*.

**2 Commencement**

These Regulations commence on the day after they are registered.

**3 Amendment of *Criminal Code Regulations 2002***

**4T Terrorist organisations — Palestinian Islamic Jihad**

- (1) For paragraph (b) of the definition of *terrorist organisation* in subsection 102.1 (1) of the Code, the organisation known as the Palestinian Islamic Jihad is specified.
- (2) For subregulation (1), Palestinian Islamic Jihad is also known by the following names:
  - (a) al-Quds Brigades;
  - (b) Harakat al-Jihad al-Islami fi Filistin;
  - (c) Islamic Jihad;
  - (d) Islamic Jihad — Palestine Faction and Islamic Holy War;
  - (e) Islamic Jihad Palestine (IJP);
  - (f) PIJ.
