



ATSIC (Regional Councils— Election of Officeholders) Repeal Regulation 2012¹

1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *ATSIC (Regional Councils—Election of Officeholders) Repeal Regulation 2012*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day after it is registered.

3 Repeal
