Amendment of List of Exempt Native Specimens – Northern Territory Demersal Fishery and Northern Territory Timor Reef Fishery, December 2019

I, Louise Vickery, Assistant Secretary, Environmental Approvals and Wildlife Trade Branch, as Delegate of the Minister for the Environment, pursuant to subsection 303DC(1)(a) of the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999* (EPBC Act), hereby amend the list of exempt native specimens established under section 303DB of the EPBC Act by **deleting** from the list specimens and any associated restrictions or conditions as set out in **Schedule 1**, and by **including** in the list specimens and associated restrictions or conditions as set out in **Schedule 2**.

This instrument is a legislative instrument for the purposes of the *Legislation Act 2003*.
