## Complaints (Australian Federal Police) Regulations<sup>2</sup> (Amendment)

After regulation 8 of the Complaints (Australian Federal Police) Regulations the following regulation is inserted:

## Standard of proof-breach of discipline

"9. The Disciplinary Tribunal shall not find that a member is guilty of a breach of discipline unless the Tribunal is satisfied beyond reasonable doubt that the member is so guilty.".
