About this compilation

The compiled instrument

This is a compilation of the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemical Products (Collection of Levy) Regulations 1995* as amended and in force on 1 July 2014. It includes any amendment affecting the compiled instrument to that date.

This compilation was prepared on 1 July 2014.

If the operation of an amendment is affected by an application, saving or transitional provision, the provision is identified in the endnotes.

Modifications

If a provision of the compiled instrument is affected by a textual modification that is in force, the text of the modifying provision is set out in the endnotes.

Provisions ceasing to have effect

If a provision of the compiled instrument has expired or otherwise ceased to have effect in accordance with a provision of the instrument, details of the provision are set out in the endnotes.

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1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemical Products (Collection of Levy) Regulations 1995*.

2 Interpretation

In these Regulations, unless the contrary intention appears:

Act means the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemical Products (Collection of Levy) Act 1994*.

6A Rate of levy—section 12C of the Act

2006-2007 financial year to 2011-2012 financial year

- (2) For section 12C of the Act, the following rates are prescribed in respect of the 2006-2007 financial year and each succeeding financial year up to and including the 2011-2012 financial year:
- (a) the rate of 0.8% for the first \$1 million of leviable disposals or part thereof;
 - (b) the rate of 0.45% for any amount in excess of the first \$1 million of leviable disposals up to and including \$5 million;
 - (c) the rate of 0.3% for any amount in excess of \$5 million of leviable disposals.

2012-2013 financial year

- (3) For section 12C of the Act, the following rates are prescribed in respect of the 2012-2013 financial year:
- (a) for the part of leviable disposals not exceeding \$1 000 000—0.70%;
 - (b) for the part of leviable disposals exceeding \$1 000 000 but not exceeding \$5 000 000—0.40%;
 - (c) for the part of leviable disposals exceeding \$5 000 000—0.28%.

Regulation 8

2013-2014 financial year and each succeeding financial year

- (4) For section 12C of the Act, the following rates are prescribed in respect of the 2013-2014 financial year and each succeeding financial year:
- (a) for the part of leviable disposals not exceeding \$1 000 000—0.63%;
 - (b) for the part of leviable disposals exceeding \$1 000 000 but not exceeding \$5 000 000—0.35%;
 - (c) for the part of leviable disposals exceeding \$5 000 000—0.25%.

8 Disclosure of information to collecting agency

- (1) This regulation applies if the Minister has specified an agency under section 3A of the Act to be the collecting agency.
- (2) The APVMA may give the collecting agency any information that the collecting agency reasonably requires in order to carry out its functions under the Act and these Regulations.
