1. Commencement

1.1 These Regulations commence on 1 July 1993.

2. Amendment

2.1 The Therapeutic Goods (Charges) Regulations are amended as set out in these Regulations.

- 3. Regulation 3 (Charges)
- 3.1 Subparagraph 3 (1) (a) (i): Omit "\$350;", substitute "\$400;".
- 3.2 Subparagraph 3 (1) (a) (ii): Omit "\$175;", substitute "\$210;".
- 3.3 Paragraph 3 (1) (b): Omit "\$60.", substitute "\$90.".
- 3.4 Paragraph 3 (2) (a): Omit "\$3,000;", substitute "\$3,400;".
- 3.5 Paragraph 3 (2) (b): Omit "\$1,500;", substitute "\$1,700;".
- 3.6 Paragraph 3 (2) (c): Omit "\$1,000.", substitute "\$1,200.".
- 4. Regulation 4 (Charges not payable when turnover is of low volume and low value)
 4.1 Paragraphs 4 (2) (a) and (b):
- 4.1 Paragraphs 4 (2) (a) and (b): Omit "2%", substitute "5%".
