A.C.T. Self-Government (Consequential Provisions) Regulations² (Amendment)

Commencement

1. These Regulations are to be taken to have commenced on 11 May 1989.

Schedule 1

2. Schedule 1 to the *A.C.T. Self-Government (Consequential Provisions) Regulations* is amended by inserting in its appropriate alphabetical position (determined on a letter-by-letter basis according to the citation of the legislation to be modified) the following:

Trade Practices Act 1974

Subsection 51 (1):

Add at the end the following word and paragraph:

“; or (d) in the case of acts or things done in the Australian Capital Territory—except as provided by the regulations, to any act or thing that is, or is of a kind, specifically authorised or approved by, or by regulations under, an enactment as defined in section 3 of the *Australian Capital Territory (Self-Government) Act 1988*.”
