## Nuclear Non-Proliferation (Safeguards) Regulations<sup>2</sup> (Amendment)

## Nuclear material to which Part II of the Act does not apply

Regulation 3 of the Nuclear Non-Proliferation (Safeguards) Regulations is amended:

- (a) by omitting from subparagraph (1) (d) (i) "or" (last occurring);
- (b) by inserting after subparagraph (1) (d) (ii) the following word and subparagraph:
  - "; or (iii) a prescribed alloy in a quantity not exceeding 10 kilograms element weight of uranium or thorium;"; and
- (c) by adding at the end the following subregulation:
  - "(3) In this regulation, a reference to a prescribed alloy shall be read as a reference to an alloy that is not:
    - (a) intended for use for the purposes of a nuclear activity;
    - (b) of a composition and purity making it suitable for fuel fabrication or for isotopic enrichment; or
    - (c) subject to the provisions of a prescribed international agreement.".
