## Superannuation (Eligible Employees) Regulations<sup>2</sup> (Amendment)

Regulation under the *Superannuation Act 1976*.

### Persons not included in definition of "eligible employee"

Regulation 4 of the Superannuation (Eligible Employees) Regulations is  
amended by adding at the end the following paragraph:

"(z) persons who:

- (i) after the commencement of section 13 of the *Governor-General Act 1974* and before 1 June 1985, became employed as members of the Governor-General's staff under that section and have continued to be, and are, so employed;
- (ii) immediately before they became so employed:
  - (A) were employed as members of the Governor-General's staff in accordance with an order under subsection 8A (1) of the *Public Service Act 1922*; and
  - (B) were not eligible employees; and
- (iii) before the commencement of these Regulations, have requested in writing to this effect, namely, not to be treated as eligible employees."
