AMENDMENT OF THE REMUNERATION TRIBUNALS (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS) **REGULATIONS†**

Regulation 5 of the Remuneration Tribunals (Miscellaneous Provisions) Regulations is repealed and the following regulation substituted:-

"5. Each of the following offices is prescribed for the purposes of paragraph Prescribed offices for the purposes of the Action 3 (4) (v) of the Act:-

- (a) the office of Inspector for the purposes of the Conciliation and (y) of the (y) of the Arbitration Act 1904;
- Remuneration Tribunals Act 1973.
- (b) the office of member of the Australian Statistics Advisory Council established under the Australian Bureau of Statistics Act 1975, being the office of a member referred to in paragraph 19(1)(c) of that Act.".
