REGULATION UNDER THE REMUNERATION TRIBUNALS ACT 1973.*

AMENDMENT OF THE REMUNERATION TRIBUNALS (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS) REGULATIONS†

Regulation 5 of the Remuneration Tribunals (Miscellaneous Provisions) Regulations is repealed and the following regulation substituted:—

"5. Each of the following offices is prescribed for the purposes of paragraph 3 (4) (v) of the Act:—

- (a) the office of Inspector for the purposes of the *Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1904*;
- (b) the office of member of the Australian Statistics Advisory Council established under the *Australian Bureau of Statistics Act 1975*, being the office of a member referred to in paragraph 19 (1)(c) of that Act."
