Remuneration Tribunals (Miscellaneous Provisions) Regulations² (Amendment)

The Remuneration Tribunals (Miscellaneous Provisions) Regulations are amended by adding at the end thereof the following regulation:

Office of part-time member of the Superannuation Fund Investment Trust

- "11. (1) A person who--
- (a) holds the office of the member of the Superannuation Fund Investment Trust referred to in paragraph 30 (1) (b) of the *Superannuation Act* 1976; and
- (b) holds any office or appointment, or is otherwise employed, on a fulltime basis in the service or employment of the Commonwealth, the Administration of a Territory, a public statutory corporation or an incorporated company all the stock or shares in the capital of which is or are beneficially owned by the Commonwealth or by a public statutory corporation,
