## Remuneration Tribunal (Miscellaneous Provisions) Regulations<sup>2</sup> (Amendment)

### 1. Amendment

1.1 The Remuneration Tribunal (Miscellaneous Provisions) Regulations are amended as set out in these Regulations.

**2.1 Add at the end:**

“(g) the office of Deputy Managing Director of the Export Finance and Insurance Corporation, being the office referred to in subsection 71 (3) of the *Export Finance and Insurance Corporation Act 1991*.”.

**3.1 Items 7 and 8:**

Omit the items.

**3.2 Item 9:**

Omit the item, substitute:

“9. Chief Executive of Commonwealth Serum Laboratories Limited

“9AA. Managing Director of the Export Finance and Insurance Corporation”.
