REGULATIONS UNDER THE NATIONAL HEALTH ACT 1953-1956.*

AMENDMENT OF THE NATIONAL HEALTH REGULATIONS.†

- 1. These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on Commencethe first day of July, 1957.
- 2. Regulation 23 of the National Health Regulations is repealed and the following regulation inserted in its stead:—
- "23.—(1.) This regulation does not apply to a Chairman or a member Fees and allowances of of a Committee who is an officer of the Public Service of the Commonwealth members of Committees. or of a State.

- "(2.) The Chairman of a Committee shall be paid a fee at the rate of Eight pounds eight shillings for each day on which he attends a meeting of the Committee.
- "(3.) A member of a Committee, other than the Chairman, shall be paid a fee at the rate of Seven pounds seven shillings for each day on which he attends a meeting of the Committee.
- (4.) The Chairman of a Committee and a member of a Committee shall be paid an allowance of Five pounds five shillings for each day or part of a day during which he is necessarily absent from his usual place of residence overnight for the purpose of attending a meeting of a Committee.".
