REGULATIONS UNDER THE NATIONAL HEALTH ACT 1953-1956.*

AMENDMENT OF THE NATIONAL HEALTH REGULATIONS.†

1. These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of July, 1957. Commence-
ment.

2. Regulation 23 of the National Health Regulations is repealed and the following regulation inserted in its stead:—

"23.—(1.) This regulation does not apply to a Chairman or a member of a Committee who is an officer of the Public Service of the Commonwealth or of a State. Fees and
allowances of
members of
Committees.

"(2.) The Chairman of a Committee shall be paid a fee at the rate of Eight pounds eight shillings for each day on which he attends a meeting of the Committee.

"(3.) A member of a Committee, other than the Chairman, shall be paid a fee at the rate of Seven pounds seven shillings for each day on which he attends a meeting of the Committee.

"(4.) The Chairman of a Committee and a member of a Committee shall be paid an allowance of Five pounds five shillings for each day or part of a day during which he is necessarily absent from his usual place of residence overnight for the purpose of attending a meeting of a Committee."
