REGULATIONS UNDER THE NATIONAL HEALTH ACT 1953-1964.*

AMENDMENTS OF THE NATIONAL HEALTH REGULATIONS†

1. Regulation 25 of the National Health Regulations is amended by— *Fees.*

- (a) omitting the words "Twelve shillings" (wherever occurring) and inserting in their stead the words "Sixteen shillings"; and
- (b) omitting the words "Fourteen shillings" (wherever occurring) and inserting in their stead the words "One pound".

2. The amendments made by the last preceding regulation apply to and in *Application.* relation to medical services rendered by a medical practitioner on and after the first day of May, 1965.
