REGULATIONS UNDER THE AIR FORCE ACT 1923.

I, THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby make the following Regulations under the *Air Force Act 1923*, to come into operation forthwith, AS FROM THE FIRST DAY OF OCTOBER, 1929.

AMENDMENT OF AIR FORCE REGULATIONS.

(Statutory Rules 1927, No. 161, amended to this date.)

(*Fourth Amendment.*)

1. Regulation 54A is amended—
 - (a) by omitting the words "medical quartermaster" (where occurring) and inserting in their stead the word "quartermaster"; and
 - (b) by omitting the words "medical branch" and inserting in their stead the words "Permanent Air Force".
2. Regulation 88 is amended by omitting from sub-regulation (4) the word "medical".
