Epidemiological Studies (Confidentiality) Regulations² (Amendment)

Declaration of studies

Regulation 3 of the Epidemiological Studies (Confidentiality) Regulations
is amended by adding at the end the following paragraphs:

- “(f) the epidemiological study in relation to a survey of illicit drug users
on patterns and predictors conducted on behalf of the
Commonwealth by the Research into Drug Abuse Program of the
National Campaign Against Drug Abuse, being the study that
commenced in May 1987;
- (g) the epidemiological study in relation to cocaine usage evaluation in
high-income groups conducted on behalf of the Commonwealth by
the Research into Drug Abuse Program of the National Campaign
Against Drug Abuse, being the study that commenced in July 1987;
- (h) the epidemiological study in relation to the extent and nature of
cocaine use by illicit drug users and upper economic strata individuals
and the assessment of recruitment and supply factors and attitudes
of identified users conducted on behalf of the Commonwealth by
the Research into Drug Abuse Program of the National Campaign
Against Drug Abuse, being the study that commenced in July 1987;

- (i) the epidemiological study in relation to persons who have been charged in a court in the State of Western Australia with an offence relating to the use of illicit drugs, conducted on behalf of the Commonwealth by the National Centre for Research into the Prevention of Drug Abuse of the National Campaign Against Drug Abuse, being the study that commenced in April 1986”.
