REGULATION UNDER THE WAR SERVICE HOMES ACT 1918-1941.\*

AMENDMENT OF THE WAR SERVICE HOMES REGULATIONS.

- 1.—(1.) Regulation 12 of the War Service Homes Regulations is amended by omitting the words "Four pounds" and inserting in their interest stead the words "Three pounds fifteen shillings".
- (2.) This regulation shall come into operation on the first day of February, 1946.
